

## SPECIAL FEATURES

**PERSONNEL:** We have a dedicated Christian staff and Christian counselors. A nurse will be on duty at all times, and lifeguards will be in charge of swimming.

**CUB BUTTONS:** A colored identification button which depicts our theme is provided and needs to be worn at all times. Take it home as a souvenir. This year, our theme is: “**Cubs In Mission!**”

**CUB CHATTER:** Each day a newspaper with news and interesting chatter is published. Each Cub will receive a copy each day and a complete set at the end of the week. It will also be posted each day on our web site. (cubweeks.org)

**SPENDING TICKETS:** Cubs need to deposit their spending money in the Concordia Cub Weeks Bank. Spending tickets in the amount of \$2.00 will be issued as needed. We recommend \$15-\$20 for the week. The camp store sells candy, pop, souvenirs, and clothing. **You may send your Cub’s spending money with your registration.**

## CUB WEEKS EXTRAS

**Group Picture** – We offer an 8 x 10 picture of each week’s Cubs, counselors, and executive staff – taken outside on the deck between the Christian Life Center and the Dining Hall. Order this at registration or during check-in for \$6. Pick up on Saturday during check-out.

**TALENT:** We give you the opportunity to voluntarily share any talent you may have, such as musical instrument solos/duets, magic acts, vocal solos/duets, drama/skits, readings, and dance routines. Don’t forget to bring your music. **You must sign up on the registration form to participate.**

## GENERAL INFORMATION

Cub Week begins with the evening meal on Sunday and ends at **10:00 A.M.** on Saturday. Please make arrangements to pick up your child at **10:00 A.M.** on Saturday.

Camp concludes at 10:00 A.M. on Saturday. You are responsible for picking up your child at that time. There is no provision for supervision afterwards.

**Registration Fees:** Early Bird Registration for Cub Weeks June 18, 2010. Registrations that are postmarked **before** the Early Bird Registration date are \$260. Registrations postmarked **after** the Early Bird Registration date are \$280.

## HEALTH AND MEDICAL RELEASE FORMS

**It is necessary for parents to sign the Medical Information Form. Cubs will not be registered if medical forms are incomplete!**

Also, please make sure that **ALL** medical information is provided that is asked for on both sides of the Medical Information Form and that we have a copy of both sides of your medical insurance card. We need to be aware of any pre-existing conditions before coming to Camp. This is very important in case of an emergency.

If you are sick, have an infectious disease or have been exposed to one, please **DO NOT COME** to Camp this year. **YOUR MONEY WILL BE REFUNDED** if we get a note from your doctor.

Upon arrival at Camp, you will be asked to furnish the nurse your Cub's medication and instructions for dispensing it to your Cub.

**INSURANCE:** Each Cub is covered by secondary insurance while at Camp which covers only accidents. It will pay only when and where your insurance does not. (Eyeglasses and illness are not covered.) Please provide all insurance information on the Medical Information form and be sure you have a copy of your medical insurance card.

## OUR CUB WEEK THEME

An exciting week is being planned for you this year at Camp Okoboji! Our 2010 theme “**Cubs in Mission**” will bring Cubs face to face with real missionaries, in Bible Study and throughout the day, to hear their stories and learn about how God is working in a variety of mission fields. (optional). -Christmas In July cabin decorations

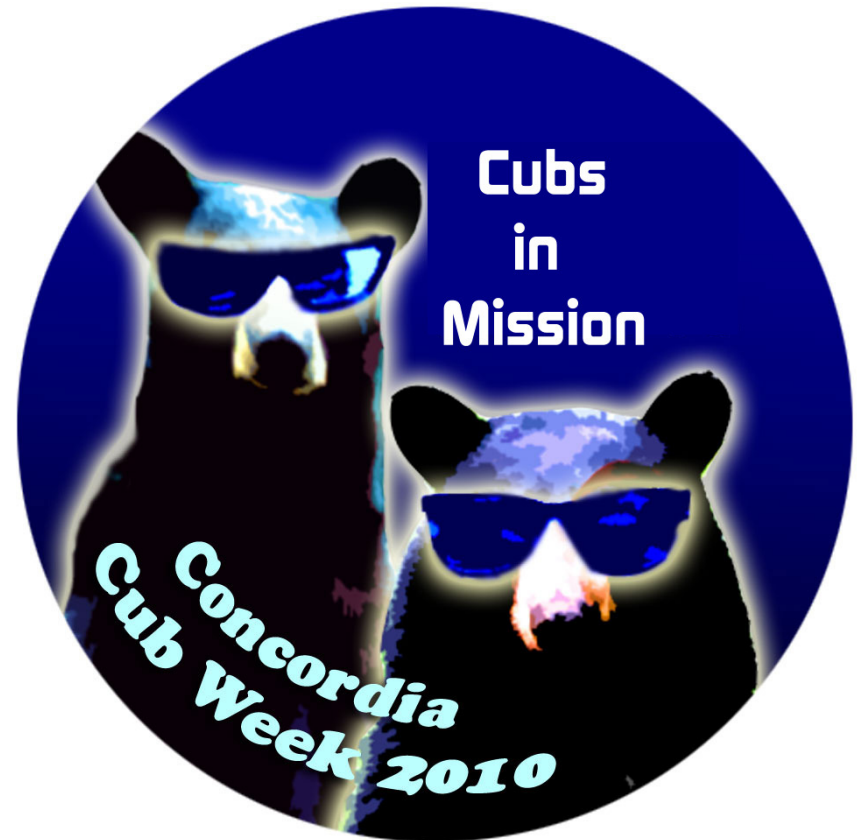
**PLEASE MARK ALL PERSONAL ITEMS
