Health and Medical Release Forms

It is necessary for parents to sign the Medical Information Form. Cubs will not be registered if medical forms are incomplete!

Also, please make sure that ALL medical information is provided that is asked for on the Medical Information Form and that we have a copy of both sides of your medical insurance card. We need to be aware of any pre-existing conditions before coming to Camp. This is very important in case of an emergency.

If you are sick, have an infectious disease or have been exposed to one, please **DO NOT COME** to Camp this year. **YOUR MONEY WILL BE REFUNDED** if we get a note from your doctor.

Upon arrival at Camp, you will be asked to furnish the nurse your Cub's medication and instructions for dispensing it to your Cub.

Our Cub Week Program

BIBLE STUDY

Devotions and Bible Study are held each day. Be sure to bring your Bible. The Bible study period will include singing familiar songs and learning new songs. Our emphasis is that we live together in Christian love as redeemed children of God and learn to share the love of Jesus with others.

SPORTS Director: Pastor Rich Merrill

A variety of team sports are planned for each day. All Cubs will be assigned to a team. Games may include: softball, volleyball, kickball, basketball, Frisbee golf, floor hockey, and soccer. There will be a swim period each day. Lifeguards will be on duty.

RECREATION Director: Pastor Michael Wolfram

Special recreational group games and activities are planned each evening of the week. Once again, we will be doing a carnival with games of skill for all Cubs!

CRAFTS Director: Pastor Ralph Shorey

A variety of crafts is offered. Here is a listing for this year. Indicate on the registration form your selection with a "1" for your first choice and a "2" for your second choice and "3" for your third choice. You will be assigned only one craft.

PLAQUE PAINTING: Paint plaster plaques. Selection includes religious pictures, mottoes, animals and figurines

LEATHER: Make a belt working with raw leather and do your own designing and finishing. All materials are provided.

COPPER: Press a design of your choosing into a sheet of soft copper. Selections include patterns of dogs, horses and nature. It can be framed.

T-SHIRT PAINTING: Paint a design from a large selection of patterns or you can bring/create a design of your own. **BRING YOUR OWN COTTON T-SHIRT OR OTHER ARTICLE OF CLOTHING.**

STRING ART: Assemble a beautiful 30" three-dimensional string art cross.

STAINED GLASS: Outline and paint a design of your choosing on Plexiglas for a stained glass effect.

MOSAICS: (New for 2011) Make a table coaster or indoor wall hanging using brightly colored mosaic tiles. You can select a design from a variety of patterns or make one of your own.

Special Features

PERSONNEL: We have a dedicated Christian staff and Christian counselors. A nurse will be on duty at all times, and lifeguards will be in charge of swimming.

CUB BUTTONS: A colored identification button which depicts our theme is provided and needs to be worn at all times. Take it home as a souvenir. This year, our theme is: **“THE GREAT ADVENTURE!”**

CUB CHATTER: Each day a newspaper with news and interesting chatter is published. Each Cub will receive a copy each day and a complete set at the end of the week. It will also be posted each day on our web site. (cubweeks.org)

SPENDING TICKETS: Cubs need to deposit their spending money in the Concordia Cub Weeks Bank. Spending tickets in the amount of \$2.00 will be issued as needed. We recommend \$15-\$20 for the week. The camp store sells candy, pop, souvenirs, and clothing. **You may send your Cub's spending money with your registration.**

We welcome gymnastic routines, ballet, and acrobatic demonstrations. Sexually suggestive interpretive dance, inappropriate clothing or song lyrics, will not be allowed. Don't forget to bring your music. **You must sign up on the registration form to participate.**

General Information

START AND END TIMES: Cub Week begins with the evening meal on Sunday (5:30pm). Camp concludes at 10:00 A.M. on Saturday. You are responsible for picking up your child at that time. There is no provision for supervision afterwards

REGISTRATION FEES: Early Bird Registration for Cub Weeks June 17, 2011. Registrations that are postmarked **before** the Early Bird Registration date are \$275. Registrations postmarked **after** the Early Bird Registration date are \$295.

The above-mentioned Registration Fee covers all fees for the week. Please make checks payable to *Camp Okoboji* when you send in your registration form. Information on District Aid may be obtained from your Pastor and on our web site.

Telephone Policy: Upon arrival, your child may call home to let you know that he/she has arrived safely. Other phone calls are made only with permission. If you anticipate that your child will need to call, please provide him or her with a prepaid phone card. They **WILL NOT** be allowed to use cell phones that they bring with them due to security reasons.
